## Milford Haven - VHF Channels

All vessels within the Haven are to keep a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel **12**, the port frequency, as well as Channels **11**, **14** and **16**. Pilot and Patrol Launches maintain a continuous listening watch on Channels **12** and **11**.

<b>9,15</b>		Allocated for berthing and unberthing operations within the main body of the Haven for use by ships, tugs, mooring boats and jetties. The channel allocation is as follows: north shore primary 9, secondary 15, south shore primary 15, secondary 9
<b>Castlemartin Firing Range</b>		
<b>16</b>		Castlemartin Range Control ' <b>Castlemartin Range Control</b> '
